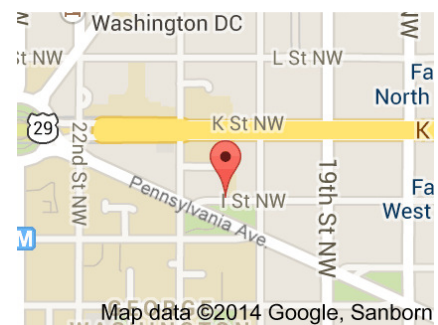
The afternoon will end with a reception in the historic rooms of the Arts Club mansion.
